The seesaw effect in gold prices is "very much related to gold's positive reaction to U.S. debt worries, with weakness from Europe sitting on the other side of the seesaw holding a very, very heavy key to the U.S. dollar," MarketWatch quoted Richard Hastings, a macro strategist at Global Hunter Securities.

"As Europe gets worse, the dollar gets stronger and heavier," so the seesaw tilts lower on the European crisis side, "waiting for a bigger load of troubles to load up the U.S. debt side — and don't worry, it's coming," Hastings said.

"We do know this much," Reuters quoted Peter Kenny, managing director at Knight Capital in Jersey City, New Jersey. "Though the resident in the White House may change, the face of Washington is still going to be one of tremendous gridlock, discord and dysfunction, and markets are going to force Washington to come to terms with the dysfunction."

US Coin Sales: Demand for Products Pick Up in November by Mike Unser on November 8, 2012

More American coins and related products realized higher gains in starting November than in ending October, U.S. Mint sales figures show.

Bullion American Eagle gold and silver coins are on fire and 69 collector coins and products logged higher weekly sales compared to the 58 noted in the previous round.

On the collectible front, 2012-W Proof American Silver Eagles topped the 800,000 milestone and were best sellers. Last year the U.S. Mint sold 850,000 individually and then another 100,000 moved with sales of the American Silver Eagle 25th Anniversary Set.
